GrantSolutions participates in a wide range of federal and industry-leading programs to ensure services and capabilities meet the highest of information security standards available. To date, GrantSolutions has undergone more than 29 IT security audit engagements assessing more than 7,400 security controls; resulting in no critical weaknesses.



A Top Priority

GrantSolutions utilizes the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) and Department of Health and Human Services policy to drive down the cost of security system authorization to operate. Resulting in cost savings of \$800,000 in tri-annual security authorization documentation and testing, and \$250,000 for annual assessments. GrantSolutions stays on top of the latest changes by participating, since its inception, in the FedRAMP continual monitoring workgroup for Amazon Web Services.



Cyber-Attack Protection and Prevention

To address NIST requirement 800-184, GrantSolutions developed a protection and prevention program to deal with known exploits. In FY18 GrantSolutions thwarted more than 150,000 cyber-attack attempts. The protection and prevention program also includes a series of tactical recovery plans to address newly emerging types of threats:

- > Fraud committed by an internal resource
- A new or augmented exploit method that defeats the perimeter security
- > A foreign state penetrates the system
